

## **HOW TO OBTAIN A MARRIAGE LICENSE**

- Both the Bride and Groom must be 18 years of age or older. If not, parental consent may be necessary.
- Both the Bride and Groom must appear in person.
- You must show proper identification and proof of age, which may include a valid driver's license, birth certificate, passport or military ID. (Documents not in English must be accompanied by certified translation)
- If EITHER the Bride or the Groom is a resident of Georgia, they can obtain their marriage license in ANY county in Georgia.
- If NEITHER the Bride or the Groom is a resident of Georgia, then they MUST go to the county to which they will be married in to get their license.
- A blood test is required. You can go to a private doctor, health department or lab in the State of Georgia.
  - Example: Any Lab Test, with many locations throughout the Atlanta area, charges \$33 per person. You will get the results back in 24-48 hours.
- The results of the blood test must be on Georgia State Form #3411 and the form MUST BE DATED. The doctor, health department or lab where you get the blood test should provide this form.
- You must obtain the marriage license within 30 DAYS of having the blood test.
- The marriage license may be over 30 days.
- Cost, method of payment and hours of operation vary by county.
